i. Stats, Programming and service updates

Eileen had a few highlights to share. The Boys Ranch School exhibit was in the gallery last month and generated lots of interest. The J.A. Jance Author Speak was held at Fuller Lodge and went over really well with about 80 people in attendance. One of the CSD promotions Talk Like A Pirate Week was held at several CSD areas and was really fun. Photos can be seen on the Facebook page. Eileen is really pleased with the collaborations that we have had with the other divisions and feels that this has a lot of potential long term benefits for all of CSD. The library had a partnership with JJAB to reach out to middle schoolers who hang out at the library. They had a pizza party in the Library Zone and brought in canvases for the kids to paint. Over 25 kids showed and really seemed to be engaged in the activity. We will be rolling out new service on October 10th called HOOPLA. It is a new subscription service that were hoping will help take some pressure off of Overdrive. The new service will offer streaming for videos, e-books, audio books, comics and music downloads. A launch party for HOOPLA will be held on October 11th down stairs in the Zone area. Patrons can bring in their device to get set up. Staff will be on hand to answer questions and refreshments will be served. October is Arts and Culture month there is a calendar of events downstairs on the display table in Reference. On October 13th the library will be open until

8:00pm for poetry readings. October is also Hispanic Heritage Month, Latin X, special story times and events will be held at the library.
