Items of note:

Historic Museum/Fuller Lodge Remodel

1. We continue to follow the work being done on the renovation and rebuild of the Guest Cottage (Los Alamos History Museum main building) and the upgrade work being done on Fuller Lodge. It is going well and the improvements are being notice as segments of the project are completed.
2. I must send a large “thank you” to the County for the Fuller Lodge east patio area upgrade. It is absolutely fabulous. The uncovering and exposure of the original stone steps leading up to the Portola is not only beautiful, but will help keep water from causing further damage to the immense roof support logs. The new larger patio, and the seamless inclusion of the ADA compliant ramp on the south side have created a much better multi-function outdoor event space. Good work!

New Assignments for the Board

1. About ten years ago a list of potentially significant sites and features throughout the county was put together. Since the passage of the Historical Preservation Ordinance, our plan is to review the list, work with property owners, and develop criteria for their inclusion and recommend them to Council. Our Board will begin to formulate a plan to move forward with these items.

Board Promotional Discussion

1. We have just begun discussion about the promotion of the FL/HDAB and the need to attract others who would be interested in volunteering. We have no vacancies at this time but want to plan for the future.
