

SUNFLOWER

This metal sculpture, which is 14 feet in diameter and made of recycled metal, has been offered to the Arts in Public Places program by the estate of Los Alamos' famous recycler and peace activist, Ed Grothus. Artist and curator Livy Snyder has proposed a process for sanding and repainting the piece, and the APP Board is looking at possible locations to install it. One proposed location is on the Eco-Station west-facing wall.
