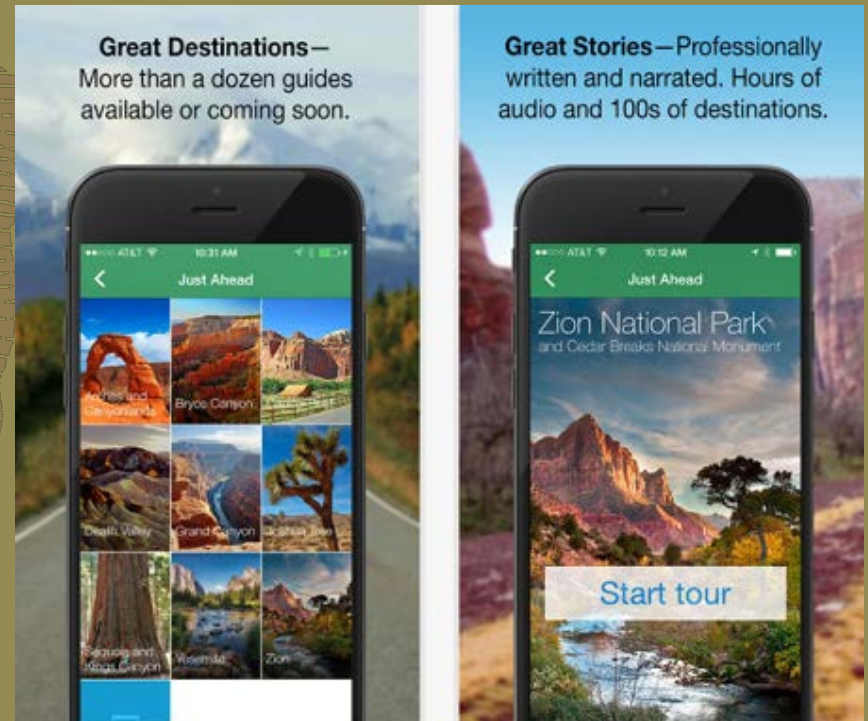
PARK UPDATE: VISITOR ACCESS PLAN
