My vision is that we have a large, bear proof food collection dumpster based near the highschool track parking lot where the glass and cardboard recycling exist. Coinciding with the implementation of the dumpster would be a program to promote/provide organics collection containers (small less than 5 gallon bins) for people to have at home and use with compostable bags. People could then collect their organics at home in the bin and drop-off the organics at the dumpster. With the county already collecting yard trimmings and composting them along with the biproduct from the waste treatment facility, the county could then add the food collection to the compost, if possible.
