I became aware that important aspects related to the "no-brainer" idea of banning plastic bags, plastic straws, and Styrofoam were not being discussed. I believe one reason this idea was brought forward again (after having been investigated and rejected just 4 years ago) was that the reasons for not accepting the ban in 2015 were not effectively noted or explained. Because there was not a solid case made for rejecting the ban in 2015 we are back to investigating it all again. I do not mean to imply there is never a good reason to bring an issue back again for new review. Rather, the reasons I have read in the newspapers for bringing the bag ban issue back for review are the same as the reasons brought forth the first time in 2015. My conclusion is that the original reasons for not accepting the ban were not clearly addressed in a memorandum to Council in 2015.
