#### Notes:

Councilor Izraelevitz gave a brief orientation stating that County Charter requires Council to appoint boards and commissions. LTAB is unique in that it also is required by state statute because of its oversight of Lodgers' Tax revenue. LTAB meetings are subject to the Public Meetings Act and must be noticed 72 hours in advance so that the public has the opportunity to attend. Councilor Izraelevitz is serving currently as the Council Liaison to LTAB. In this role, he does not vote or direct LTAB's actions, rather, he serves as an information conduit between the Council and LTAB.

#### **General Information**

All County Board and Commission members must be residents of Los Alamos County. Lodgers' Tax Advisory Board members, except the at-large community member, do <u>not</u> need to be residents if they are employed/represent an attraction or hotel.
