Member Chamberlin reported that items covered during the meeting included: Atomic City Transit is expecting an impact on the White Rock routes due to NM 502 construction, there is a proposal to add service to the Truck Route in order to deflect traffic from Main Hill. A motion was passed for a proclamation to be declared at the May 2nd County Council Meeting establishing May as Bike to Work Month and May 19th as Bike to Work Day. A subcommittee has been established to look into improving bike trails and focusing on improving biker's safety. Don Machen, Transportation Board Liaison, reported that traffic calming projects were also discussed.
