Route 2 Peak Service

Annette Granillo, Transit Manager presented the proposed Peak Service to White Rock

- 2M Current service from White Rock through Main Hill servicing the downtown area, finishing at the Transit Center
- 2M Map Service loop around White Rock to Los Alamos using Main Hill to the downtown area
- July 2017 Ridership Report
- 2T Current service within White Rock to the Transit Center through the truck route
- 2T Map Service within White Rock to the Transit Center
- 2 Peak Is a proposal combination of 2M and 2T. It would service
 the current 2M loop clockwise in the morning and counter clockwise
 in the afternoon also servicing down town in Los Alamos area via the
 truck route
- 2 Peak provides clockwise loop in White Rock in the morning with counter clockwise loop in the evening
- 2 Peak service provides additional service to White Rock with the same benefits as 2M (direct service to downtown locations) via the Truck Route
- Is in anticipation of upcoming construction on the 502 round-about project which will affect the 2M on-time performance
- Services major employment locations like TA-3, Los Alamos Hospital, Del Norte and Zia Banks, Municipal Building, and Los Alamos High School (High School will arrive 6 minutes after bell rings but is serviceable in the afternoon)
- New service will start October 16, 2017
