Results from the 2018 Community Survey

The County's bi-annual community survey results will be presented by Rachelle Howell and Chris Cordova from Southwest Planning & Marketing, Inc. this evening. Southwest Planning & Marketing, Inc was hired in May to conduct the survey. They randomly selected 400 County residents to participate in a short phone survey. The survey included a variety of questions about County programs and services, community needs, quality of life and openness and transparency of government. The County has been regularly conducting community surveys since 1996. County staff use the information gained from the survey to help guide decisions about improvements as part of its "LA Scores" performance measurement program.
