The Library offers opportunities for our diverse regional community to learn, know, gather, and grow by providing open and equal access to a variety of ideas and information through evolving technology and services.

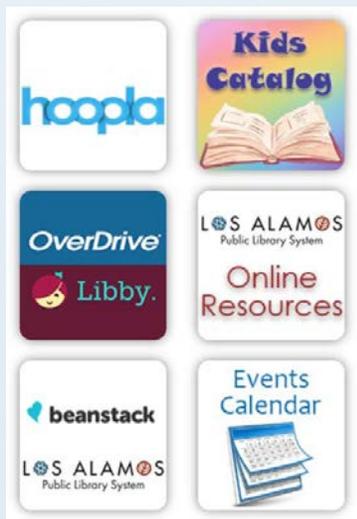
FY 2022 Board Activities

- Still limited due to COVID procedures.
- Welcomed one new member, and one returning member. (we have a full board)
- Assisted in thanking our Library staff for National Library Week.
- In conversation about getting back into the community to interact and receive feedback.
- Heard reports from library staff on accessibility and technology
- Preparing to welcome a new Library Manager.



Library COVID Response

- Curbside pick-up has remained, and hours extended again during "surge."
- Virtual, hybrid and outdoor activities
- Increased usage and promotion of digital resources.
- Temporary closure when called for by the county.



- Decreased number of computers available – social distancing and technology concerns.
- Increasing number of programs as it is deemed safer to do so.

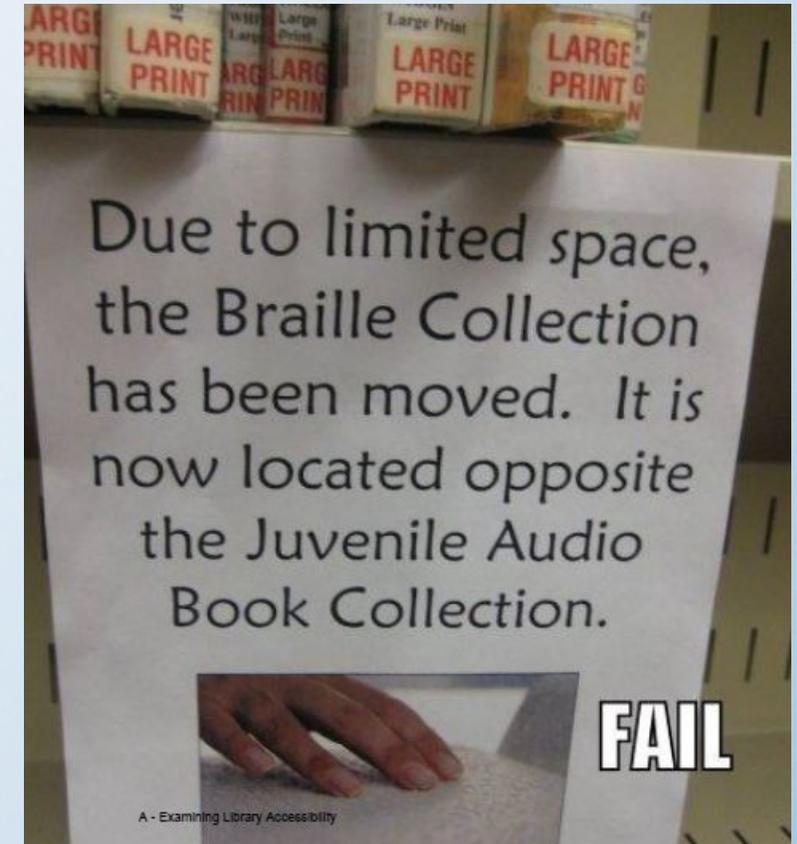
Friends of the Los Alamos County Libraries

- Members of the Board served as liaisons to the Friends of the Los Alamos County Libraries and attend their meetings.
- Opened up more hours based upon volunteer availability.
- Friends donated approximately \$25,000 to the library last year through their bookstore activities and community donations.



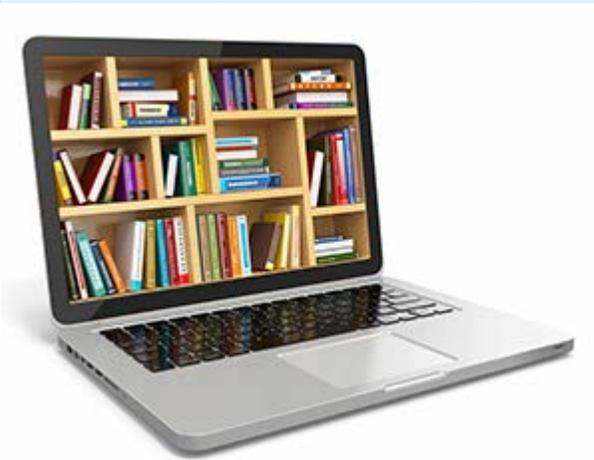
Accessibility

- Library staff presented to the Board and to the State Library Association on Accessibility issues in libraries.
- Did an accessibility audit of the library to assess spaces, services and staff, which included working with advocacy groups
- Learn and grow
- Provide training, education and resources at the library on accessibility topics
- Recognize that this is not one-and-done.



Technology

- Increase in demand for digital resources in many forms.
- Increase in demand for library services outside the physical building.
- Need to address equity, diversity and inclusivity for all services.
- Disaster preparedness and the role libraries play
- Increased concern for technology and privacy
 - Budget constraints
 - Patron Computer usage and availability
 - Hiring for technology and website development

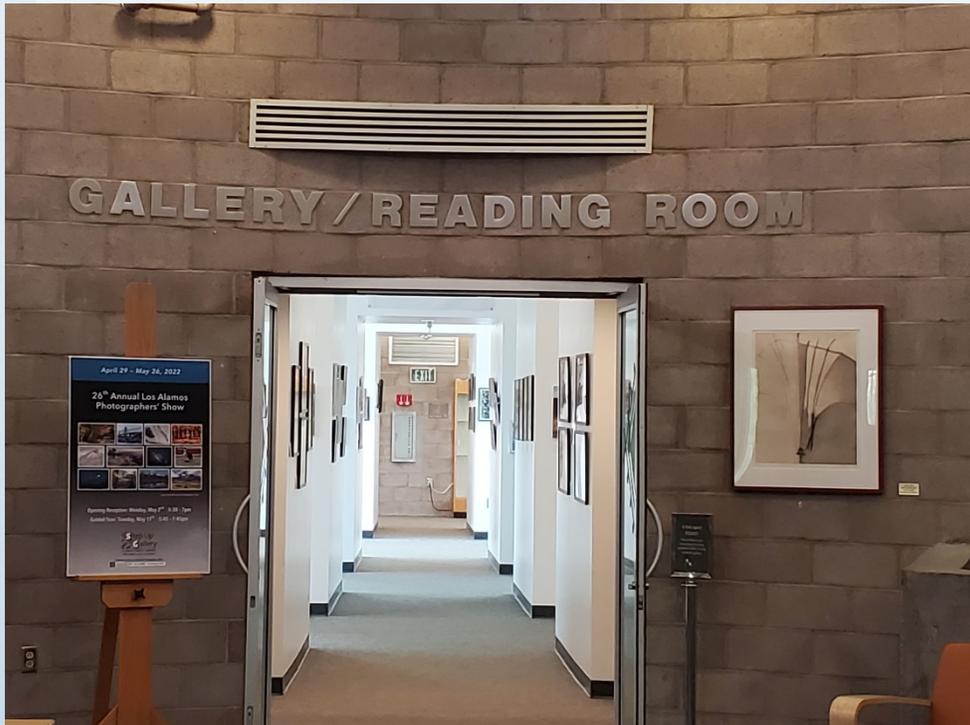


What's Next...
