She shared progress on the Trails and Open Space Management Plan, and noted that the draft concept for the Synthetic Turf Master Plan will be presented to the Parks and Recreation Board in August. She reported that the playground renovation at 37th Street and Piñon Park was approved by Council on July 8. Additional updates included renovation work on sports fields, development of the Brewer Arena plan footprint, and that construction at East Park and North Mesa remains on track.
