Concern Raised; Clarification Sought

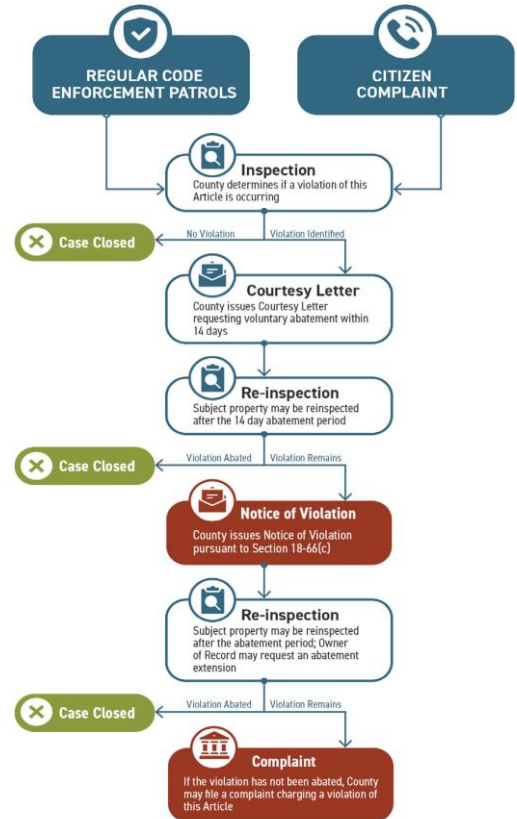
- Concern raised about impacts of nuisance code violations on security clearances
