Describe the purpose of the grant and what will be accomplished: <u>The Los Alamos Fire Department</u> would like to seek funding through the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) to replace aging LifePak Cardiac Monitors essential for advanced life support. Our current fleet of 18 LifePak15 monitors is nearing the end of service, with 13 units unserviceable and 5 nearing expiration. LAFD is purchasing 6 new monitors for our medic units (pricing available through SourceWell pricing agreements). Grant funding would enable the purchase of 12 additional monitors, ensuring complete fleet replacement and uniformity. These devices are critical in delivering advanced life support and emergency medical services to our community.
