

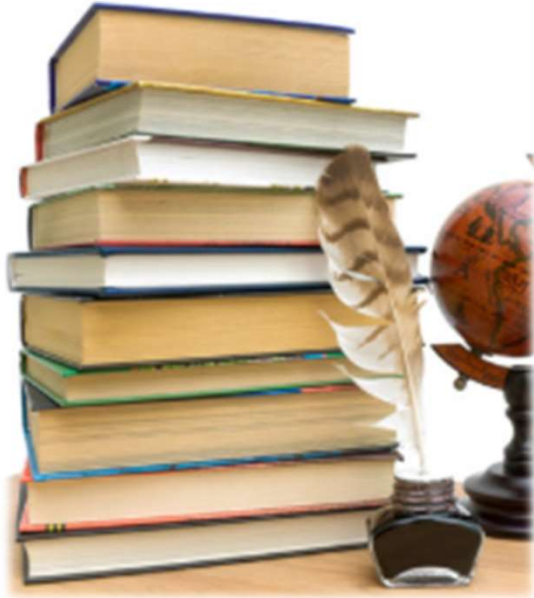

History



Policy 1735 is the County policy that governs the use and rental of County-owned facilities and land.



The last comprehensive review and update for this policy was completed in 2021, and prior to that was in 2006.

Preparing for these changes

Multiple meetings were held with all divisions within Community Services, as well as other County departments to review, agree upon, and update facility lists, descriptions, and proposed pricing.

- All descriptions, fees and charges within 1735 were reviewed, analyzed, and updated.
- Not all fees were changed.

Highlights of **key changes** to the current version of Policy 1735 include:

- "One-rate" for most fees
- Added mobile and food vending opportunities
- Free admission for foster families and children in CYFD custody
- Family rates
