- F. [21272-26](#) DWI Prevention Efforts- Sylvia Diehl, Eli Argo, & Lauren Tomko
- Sylvia spreading the word of prevention through self-care and the Arrive Alive Car coming to Los Alamos High School (LAHS campus). She stated that the Safe Prom video that the school launched was very well received. The school is also doing video recorded advisory session with Dianna Tores from Juvenile Just Advisory Board (JJAB) and continuing the Facebook outreach to parents with DWI related content. They are still in the hiring process for the tobacco use prevention grant.

Jordan told the council that there are more rideshare drivers available in Los Alamos on evenings and weekends. There was then discussion on using the drivers for special events possible using DWI funds to help advertise and maybe offer a coupon for using the rideshare services.

Jamie noted that the Atomic City Transit does on demand rides early morning and evening Monday through Friday.
