- 14 Hospital, new roundabout, diamond drive roundabout, UNM-LA

- 15 county budget. Most of the "art in public" place in this town is dreadful and should be torn down or sold off.

- 17 Los Alamos Medical Center / Hospital. Urban Park.
- 18 Overlook Park, Rover Park
- 19 In middle of park which is directly along side parking area of County building and Central Ave.
- 20 I feel we do not need anymore art in Los Alamos. Please reconsider this unnecessary expense.
- 21 a large flat metal sculpture depicting many equestrian/livestock pursuits on the W facing wall of the covered arena on North Mesa.
- 22 No additional
- 23 Move the Clowns from in front of Mesa Library and put something new there. The Clowns could go in WR near the softball fields.
- 24 More in White Rock and maybe more around Ashley Pond and Fuller Lodge.
The strip mall that has The Tub, Pet Pangea, etc. is boring white. It would look great to paint each
- 25 separate stores facade to see all the different stores with painted murals. Barranca could also use public art at the new school and the park.
- 26 Parks, trails, public spaces
Would love to see something as people come into town. Eventually at the roundabout of course, but how about something along the boring airport fence? There are cool installation ideas for fencing that can be done in a tasteful way. Something black and white as an ode to our history? Partnering with the
- 27 Los Alamos Creative District on a mural downtown, something freestanding or on County property?
There are lots of ideas currently documented but isn't immediate funding available but may be through this group. Whatever the plan, would love for it to have a placemaking element in conjunction with the Downtown Master Plans.
- 28 Urban Park. Corner Trinity & Diamond near lemon lot visible from stop light. In the new roundabout coming in to town

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- 29 Barranca and North Mesa areas. Bring art to the upper mesas!
- 30 I would love to see murals on the sides of buildings. I miss this sort of thing since moving here.
- 31 At the triangle formed by central and trinity and at every school.
- 32 Has any decision been made about the Segler painting in Fuller Lodge?

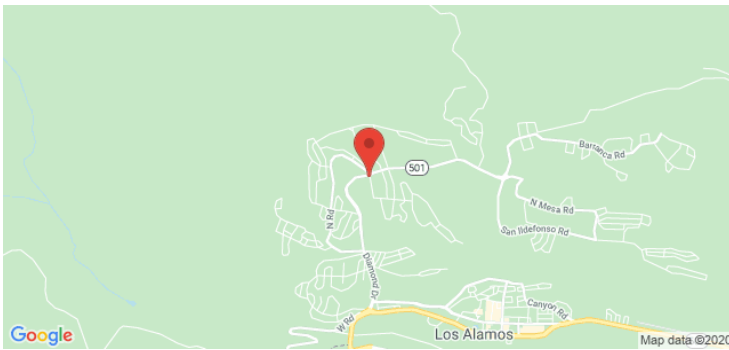
