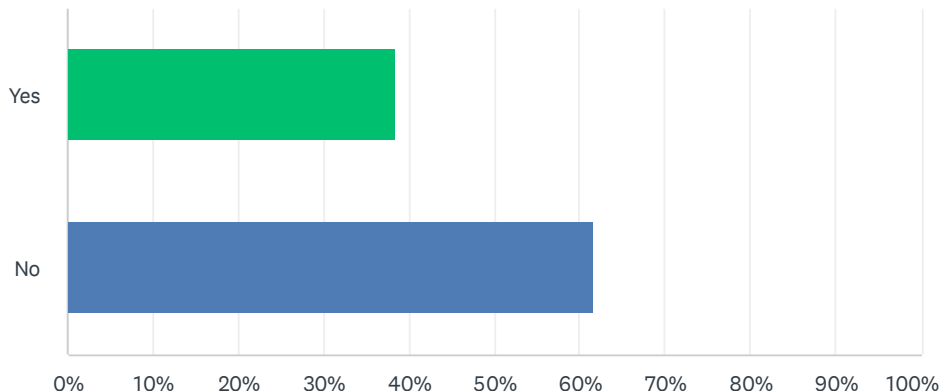


Q1 Do you feel like this artwork would be a good fit for the golf course wall?

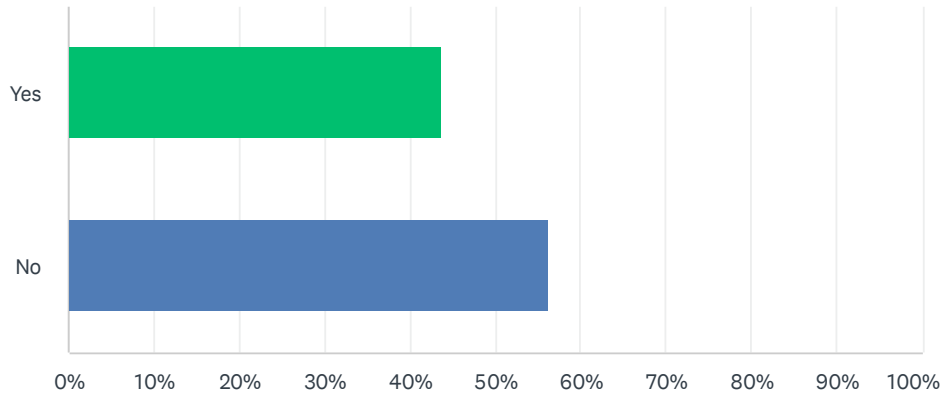
