PROJECT BACKGROUND

- County Identified Priority Project
 - Joint Project: Public Works and Department of Public Utilities
- Project Summary & Budget
 - Roadway Improvements
 - Project Selection Based on Pavement Condition Indices (PCI)
 - Project Area Average PCI: 46.5
 - Scale: 1 - 100 (newly paved road)
 - Programmed in Fiscal Year 2027 Capital Improvement Program (CIP): \$3,800,000
 - Utility Improvements
 - Joint Utility Project Programmed in DPU 10-Year Plan: \$1,200,000
 - Broadband Installation

PROJECT SCOPE: ROADWAY

- Road Reconstruction: 4" Asphalt
- Targeted Installation or Replacement of:
 - Curb and Gutter
 - Valley Gutters
 - Sidewalk
 - Drive Pads
 - ADA Compliant Ramps
 - Broadband Infrastructure
- Design completed by Public Works Engineering Staff

PROJECT SCOPE: UTILITIES

- Replacement of water distribution line, water services and new water meter cans
- Design completed by Public Utilities Engineering Staff



PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction

- Anticipated Bid Summer 2026
- Anticipated Completion Spring/Summer 2027

- Los Alamos County Environmental Services – Trash and Recycling Pickup
- Los Alamos Public Schools – Transportation School Bus Routes
- USPS/UPS/FedEx – Mail Delivery
- Residential Access
- Senior Center Meals on Wheels
- Public Safety & Emergency Services

PROJECT COORDINATION

- Traffic Management
 - Vehicular, bicycle & pedestrian access to be maintained
 - Phased to minimize construction impact and maximize safety.
 - Clearly marked work zones and detours.
- Work Hours: To be determined, typically 7:00 AM- 5:00 PM
 - County Noise Permit required for any work proposed from 9:00PM to 7:00AM
- Dust Control: Maintained daily with water truck
