Chair Deck called the meeting to order at 12:05 pm.

Vice-Chair Allen, whose term also is set to expire after the November meeting, affirmed he will reapply to a second term on the Board.

Member Ruud announced that she will be leaving the Comfort Inn and the state and that this will be her last meeting as a board member.

Ms. Stewart confirmed that LTAB will begin seeking a lodging representative and an attraction representative to fill the two vacancies.

Member Olsen volunteered to take on the Acting Chair position once it becomes vacant by Chair Deck's departure until the new year when Chair and Vice-Chair will be voted on at the first meeting.

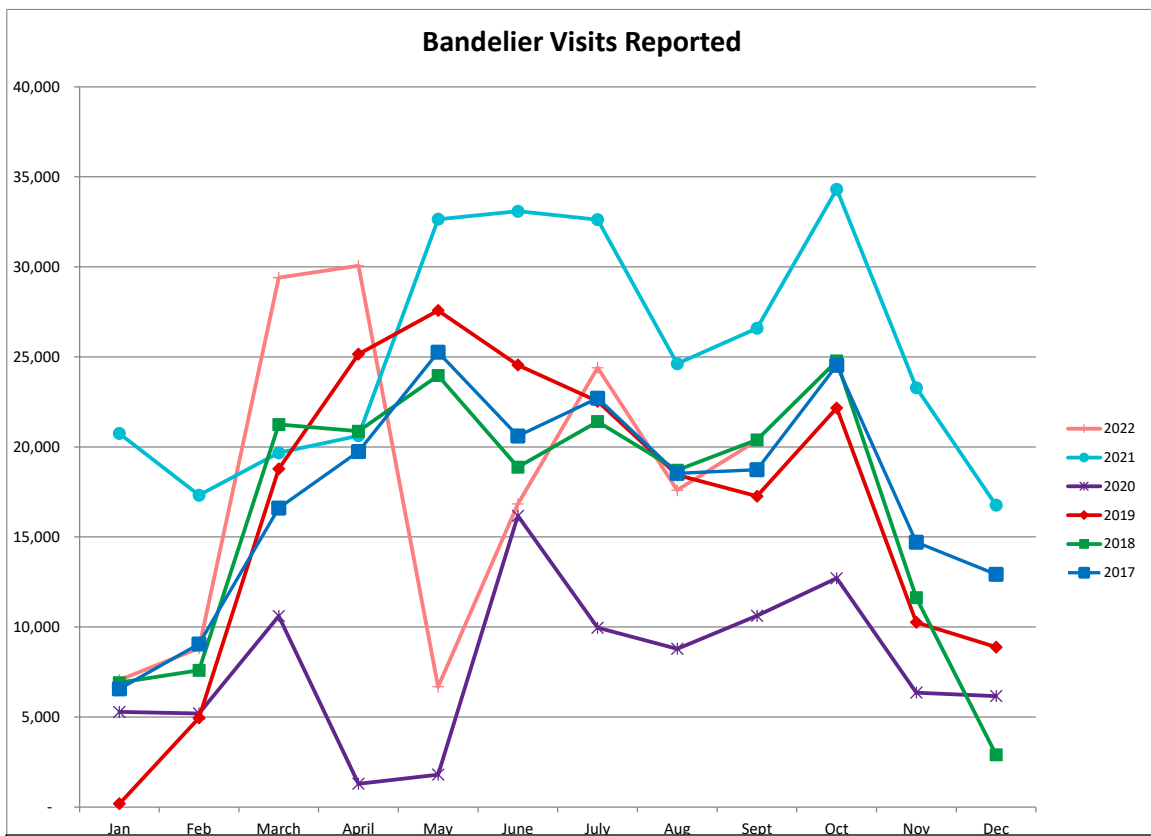
Visitor Centers reopened normal business hours on March 17, 2021

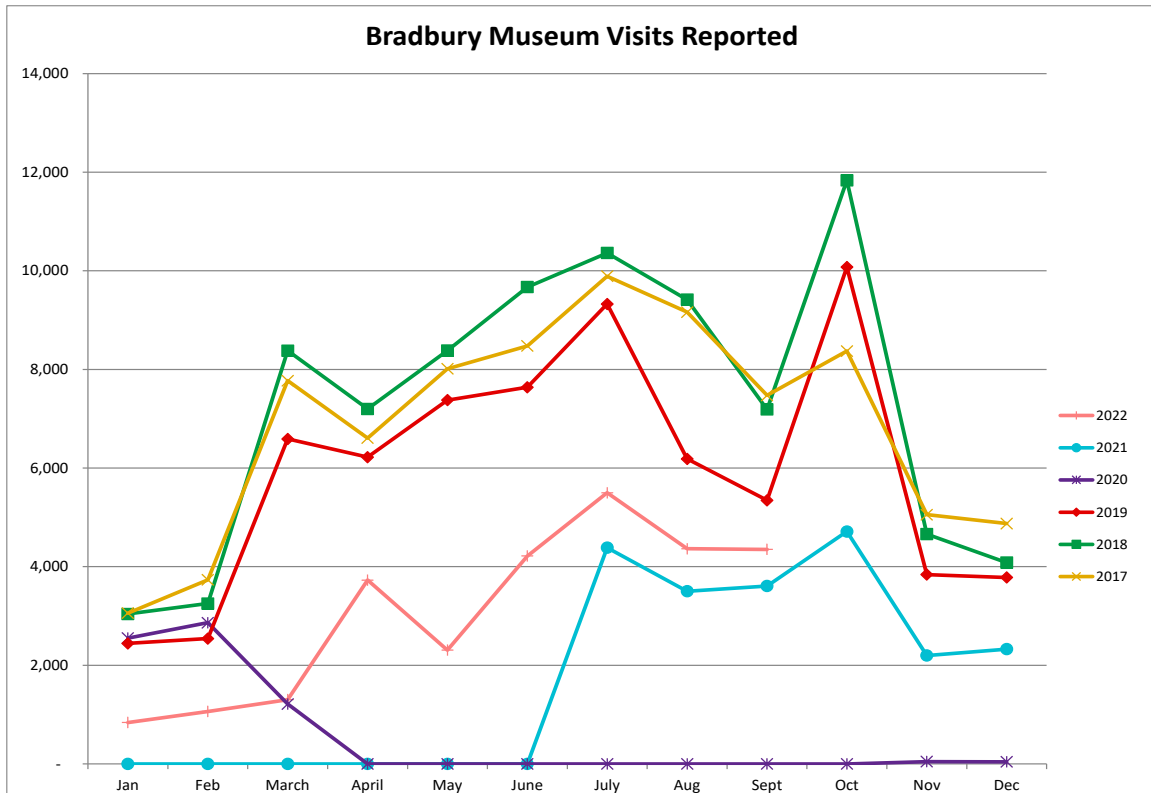

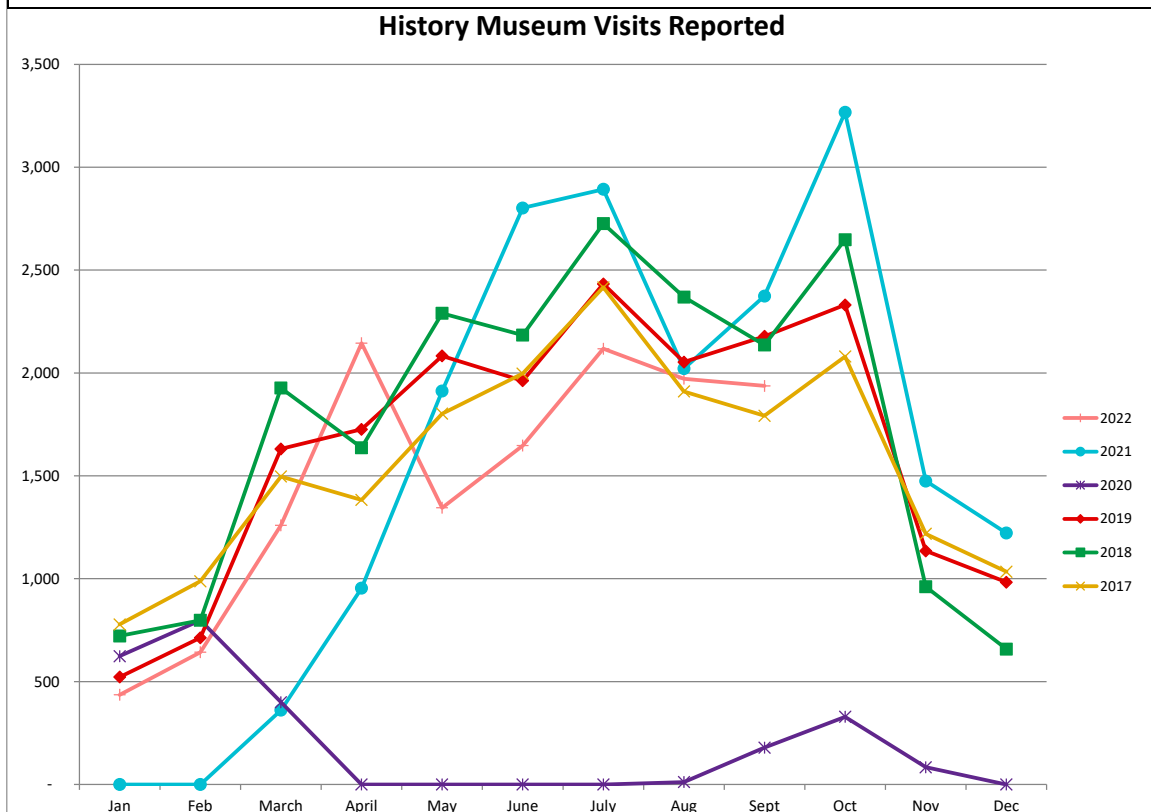

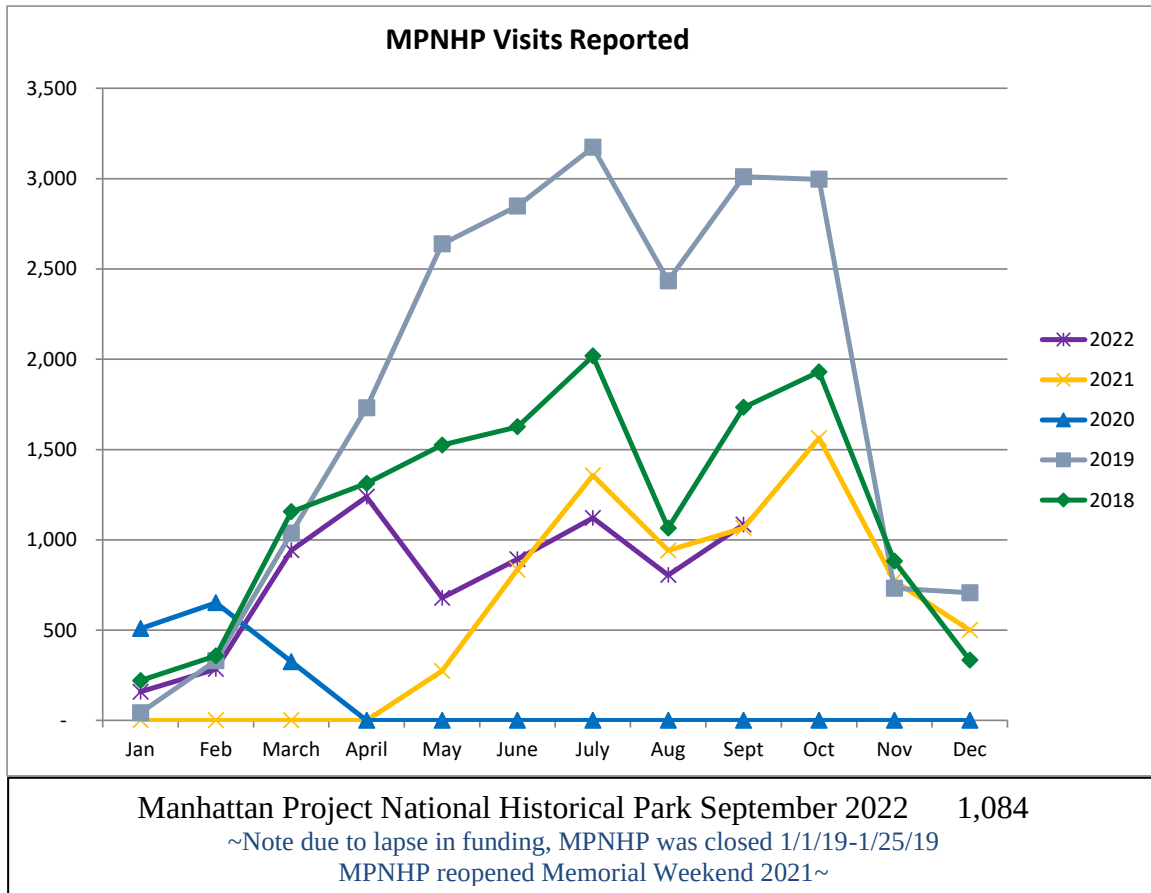
Bradbury Science Museum September 2022 4,350

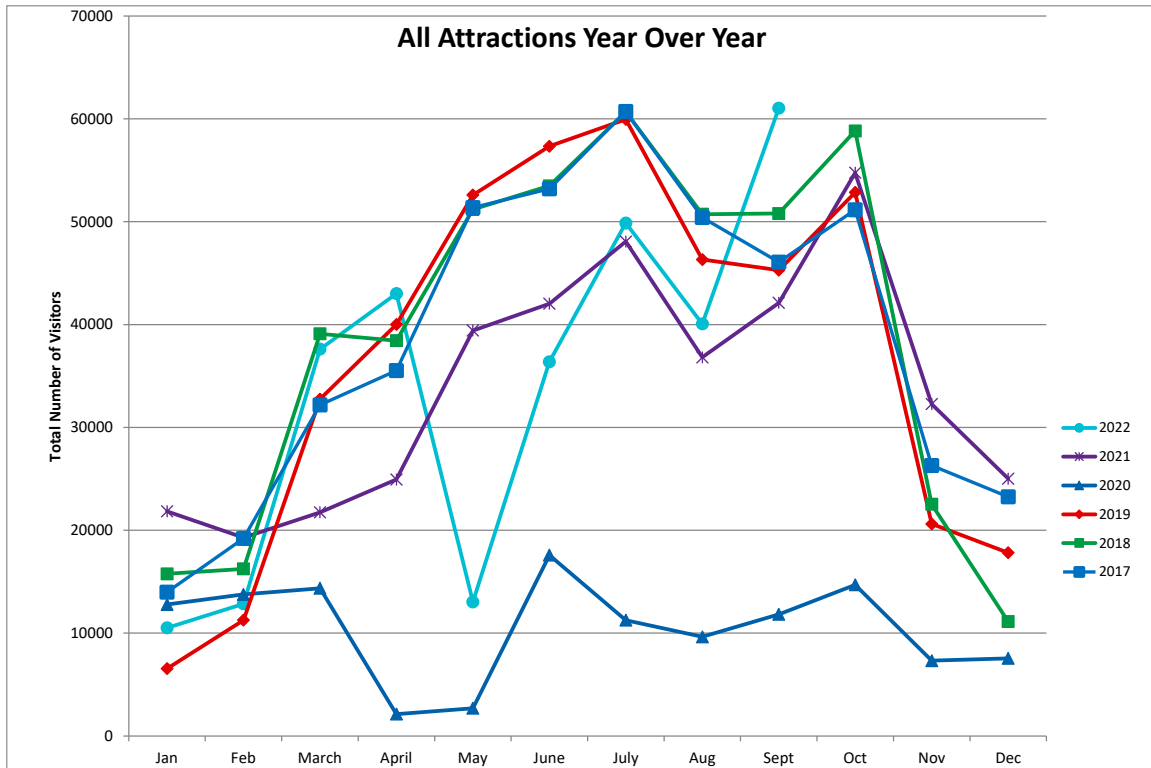

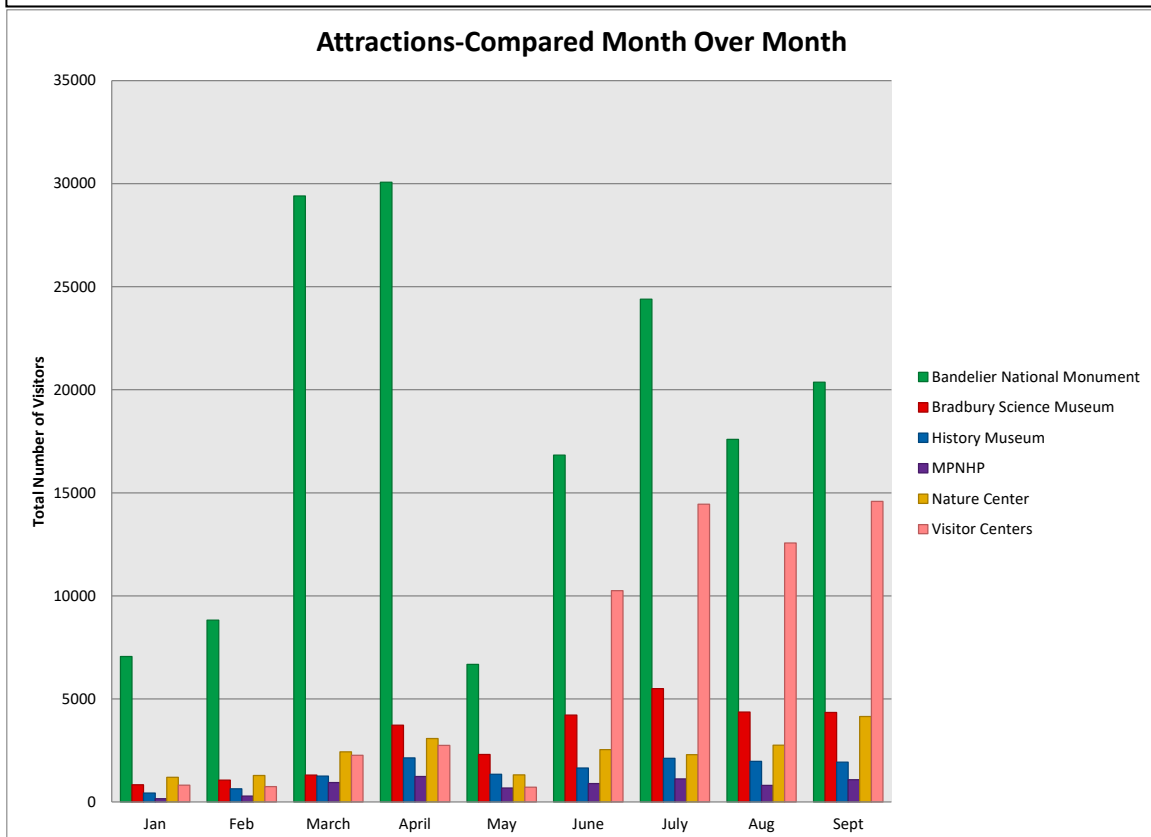

September Narrative Comments:

- The new 2022 Los Alamos Adventure Guide's has been delivered to DLA's storage unit. Approximately **20,000** copies are currently in storage. Fun and Games picked up over 200 boxes of the new Adventure Guides in September. 6 boxes for LANL- Recruiting Events Coordinator, HR - Office of Diversity and Strategic Staffing.
- Event material in kiosks and the displays are updated weekly or as needed by a DLA representative. These contain a weekly Concierge Calendar and are restocked with 8-10 different Los Alamos County tourism pamphlets. There are currently **28** in place in the Los Alamos, LANL and White Rock areas.
- All state-managed visitor centers were contacted during the month to ensure they have Los Alamos Visitor Guides in stock. Similarly, local distribution points are also monitored. These are filled by our contractors Fun & Games out of Albuquerque and Brochure Distribution out of Santa Fe.
- DLA's website www.visitlosalamos.org and events info feeding www.fyilosalamos.com are updated on a weekly basis with events and information.
- DLA recruits, trains, and manages volunteers for a variety of work. There were **28** volunteer hours logged for the month of September.
- WRVC Business Display Cases featured the Nature Center (PEEC), Gadgets (Bradbury Science Museum), Bathtub Row Brewing Coop, Flower's by Gillian, Seeking Chameleon, Rose Chocolatier, The Cricket Window, Pet Pangaea, Hampton Inn & Suites, High Mesa Dental Arts, LA Doghouse, Hilltop Spa and Fran Stoval were on display for the month of September. The large display featured the Bradbury Science Museum.
- In September, DLA helped the following groups/events requesting assistance in promoting and planning their upcoming planned and/or potential events in 2022. We provide tourism materials and information as needed for each group.

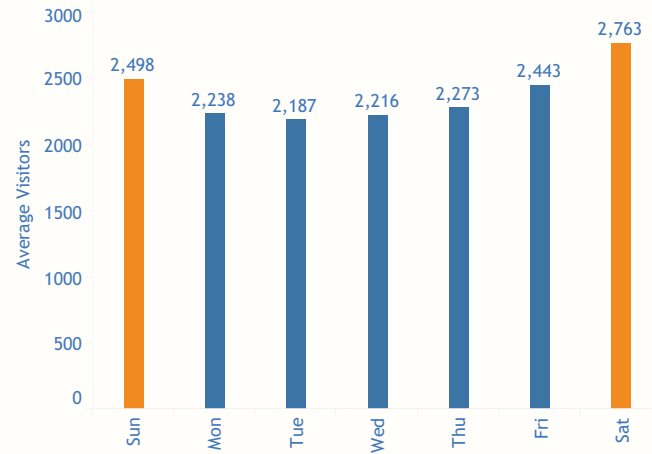

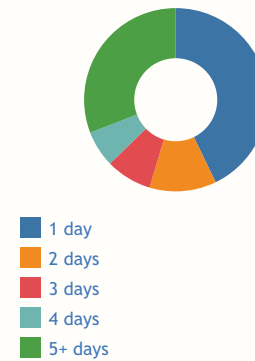

Weekday vs Weekend



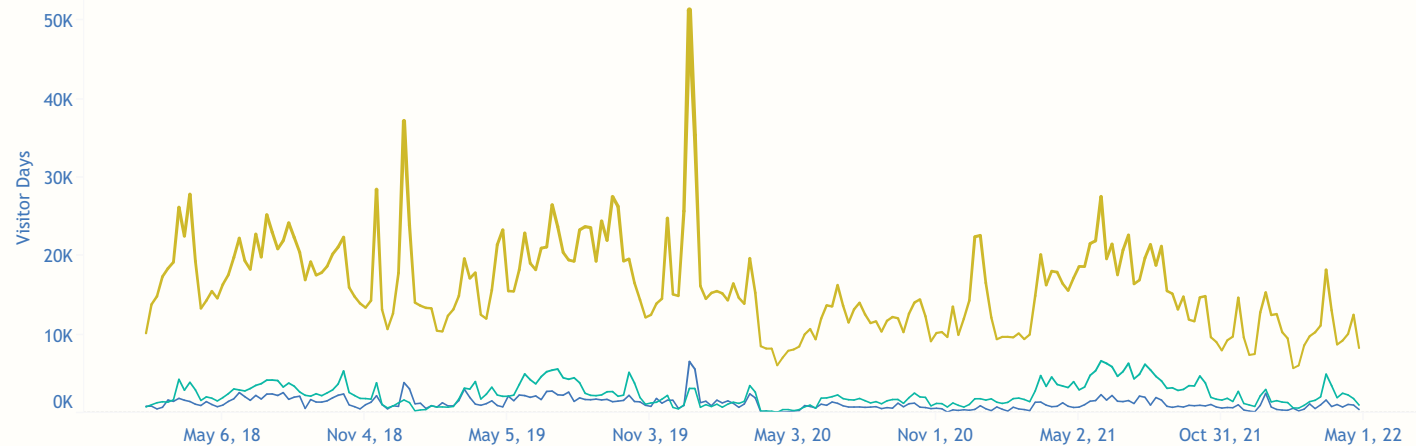
Trip Length

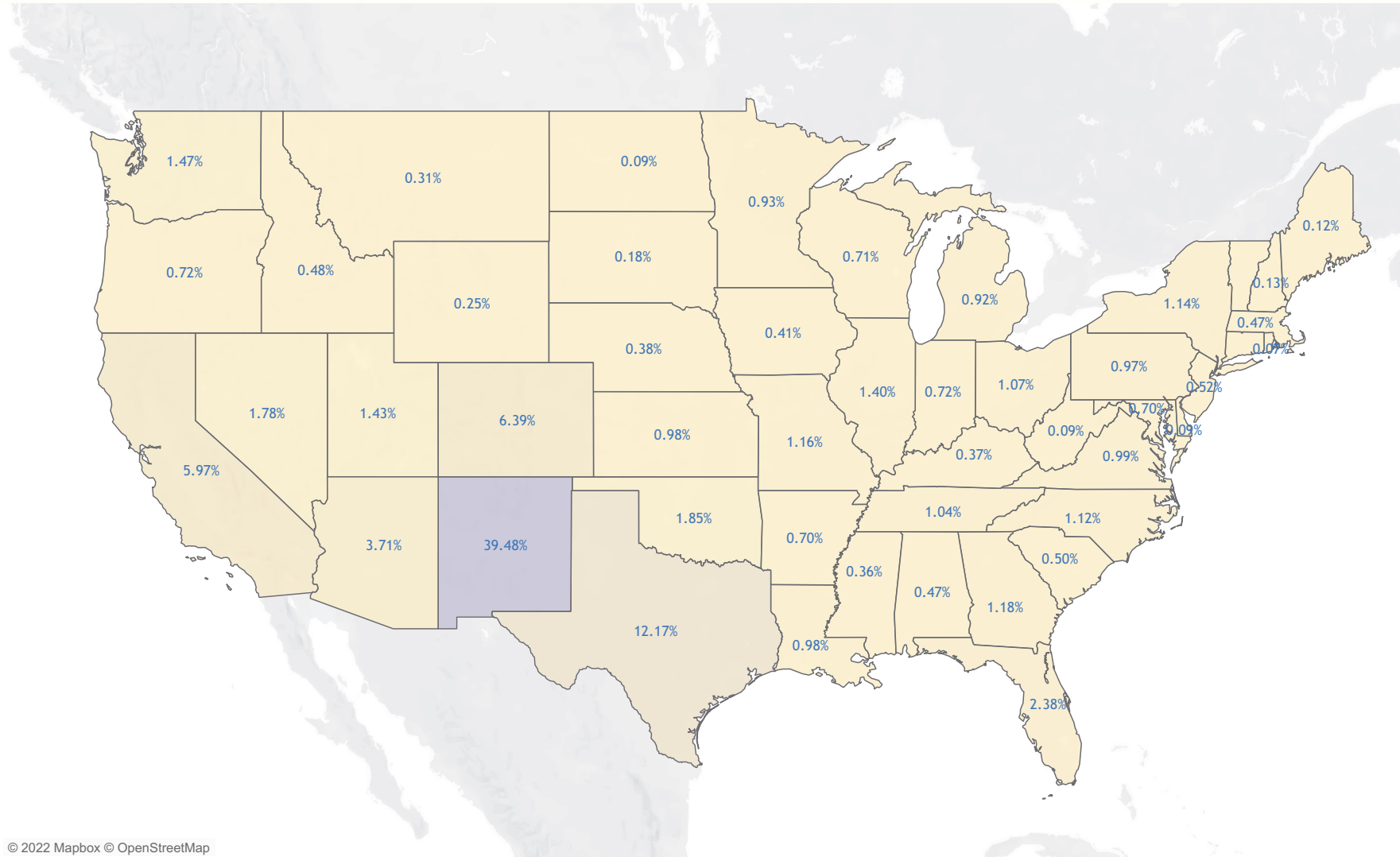
Weekly Activity Visitor Days
