Over the last ten years I have built numerous projects for events, private clients, and public installations. I have transported and installed sculptures across the country and as far as Toronto, Canada. My extensive experience organizing sculpture installation logistics as well as build logistics will allow me to produce a successful sculpture for this project within budget and on time.

I am detail oriented, flexible, and I care deeply about my work and the people I am working for. Completing successful installations is the core focus of my life and I love building sculptures with all of my heart. Creating public art is important for me so I can share my passion with the world. 
