IV. BOARD/STAFF COMMUNICATIONS

- A [21035-26](#) DWI Prevention Efforts- Sylvia Diehl, Rachel Mohr-Richards, Eli Argo, & Lauren Tomko
- Councilor Sylvia Diehl announced that the school received the Tobacco Grant. The tobacco grant allows LAPS to pay students to work four hours per week creating social media content and doing classroom outreach to prevent tobacco use.
- The Breathe for Change SLAT teacher training is nearing its end. Still trying to get the Arrive Alive car to attend.
- Having a pre-prom event meeting to schedule an event aimed at reducing drinking and driving and dating violence during prom.
- Councilor Eli spoke to a group about building a program to foster resiliency in teens, the program will be very expensive, and the Teen Center might request funding from DWI council to help fund it. They are offering a pre-party for the Saturday movies that JJAB sponsors at SALA. The Teen Center is working with the school for Spring Fling dance preparations. Teen center is anticipating their role will be to bring food, snacks and games and facilitate a quiet place for teens to go and have less stimulus. The Teen Center is also working with SALA for the Spring Fling midnight movie and is expecting 75 teens.
- Staff Liaison Lauren Tomko talked about her future plans for the program such as helping to sponsor local businesses sober events and hosting summer trivia.
- A pre-summer concert event was suggested.
- Chair Juanita said they are working with the schools to bring the “Arrive Alive Tour” back.
- Chair Juanita went on to talk about hosting another sober event. The mocktails were very popular at the last event.

B [21036-26](#) DWI Treatment - Jordan Redmond and Adrianna Delvo

Counselor Adrianna said they have 16 active clients at RAC STOP in IOP. This number is lower than normal, and she believes its due to additional treatment centers opening. RAC STOP is fully staffed but are still looking to hire an assistant for groups in the evenings. They have added a seeking safety curriculum, and all their staff have been trained on it. Currently there are no referrals from Los Alamos, so it has been quiet. Aftercare has changed to monthly sessions with their assigned therapist instead of evening group meetings. The length of aftercare can be up to 6 months and is assessed on an individual basis.

Councilor Lauren Smith gave an end of year update: there were a total of 55 DWI, 18 sent to treatment for alcohol, two domestics involving alcohol, two battery involving alcohol, twelve positive tests in the work place for alcohol, two positives for drugs, and 17 'other' cases. There was a total of 112 cases during 2025. The majority of offenders are male and DWI's continue to make up most cases. The number of cases decreased slightly from 2024 (114). In 2026 there have been three DWI cases reported, one person went into treatment, and one case of battery involving alcohol. Councilor Adrianna mentioned seeing similar gender trends in treatment.

Activities include roller skating, barbeque, tipsy carts, firefighter challenge, carnival, limbo and smoothies, fractal show at PEEC, climbing wall, games night, activities at the library, laser tag and movies. Breakfast is served in the early morning of the Sunday after graduation. Every student who has participated in all activities during the event are eligible to enter in the drawing for really awesome grand prizes.
