American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Allocation of Uses Plan

Category	Range to Earmark
A. To respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality	70% - 75% (\$2,633,541 - \$2,821,651)
D. To make necessary investments in water, sewer and broadband infrastructure	25% - 30% (\$940,550 - \$1,128,660)

- Engage in community survey to identify high priority areas of need that are eligible uses under Category A
- Return to Council with recommendations and/or budget requests by program
