

ITF Report from KokHeong McNaughton (from May 7th to May 28)

- **5/7/25 Accessibility Working Group on Zoom.** 8 people attended. Shared visioning responses. Fixed the following dates for guided tours of both Senior Centers and County Libraries.

1) **Wednesday May 21**, 5-6 PM: Mesa Public Library

2) **Wednesday June 4**, 3-4 PM: Los Alamos Senior Center

3) **Wednesday, June 25**, 3-4 PM: White Rock Senior Center, followed by White Rock Branch Library.

We plan to set up a table during the July 11th Friday Night Concert at Ashley Pond for the purpose of gathering public inputs as well as distributing relevant accessibility materials.

- **5/8/25 Park & Rec Board.** The result of the second survey on shade structure for the Ice Rink was presented. 94% of the 764 participants are LA residents. Of the two final models presented, the majority of participants favored the sloped structure with fixed canopy. The group plans to make their recommendation to County Council during the June 10th meeting. Park Superintendent Wendy Parker presented the Guaje Pine cemetery's Master Plan which includes a green burial option. The plan will be opened to public comments on May 14th.
- **5/21/25 Accessibility Working Group guided Tour** of Mesa Public Library. Five members of the group plus two additional family members attended the guided tour of Mesa Public Library conducted by Norma Covington. The library was built in 1994 when ADA guidelines were different than they are now. Many of the features have to be upgraded continuously and are still in the works. The tour was very informative and we learned a lot about current and future accessibility upgrades.
