

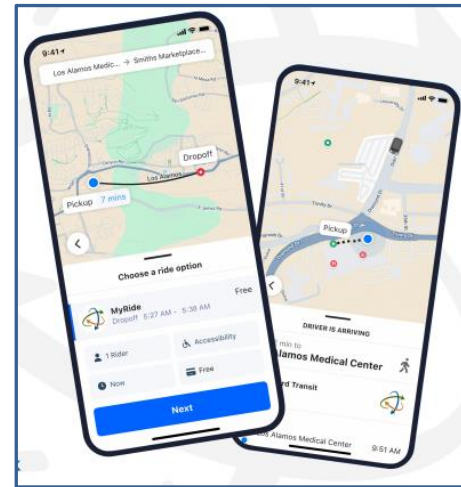

# Proposed Saturday Service Pilot

**Service Type:** On-demand with Reservations and Dispatching Managed by the MyRide Software

**Reservations:** First come, first serve. Made through MyRide App or by calling 505-664-RIDE

**Service Area:** Los Alamos & White Rock

**Start:** Saturday August 2

**End:** Saturday October 25

# Proposed Saturday Service Pilot

**Schedule:** 1<sup>st</sup> pickup 9:00AM, last pickup 5:30PM

**Staffing:** 1 Supervisor (already scheduled for Bandelier)

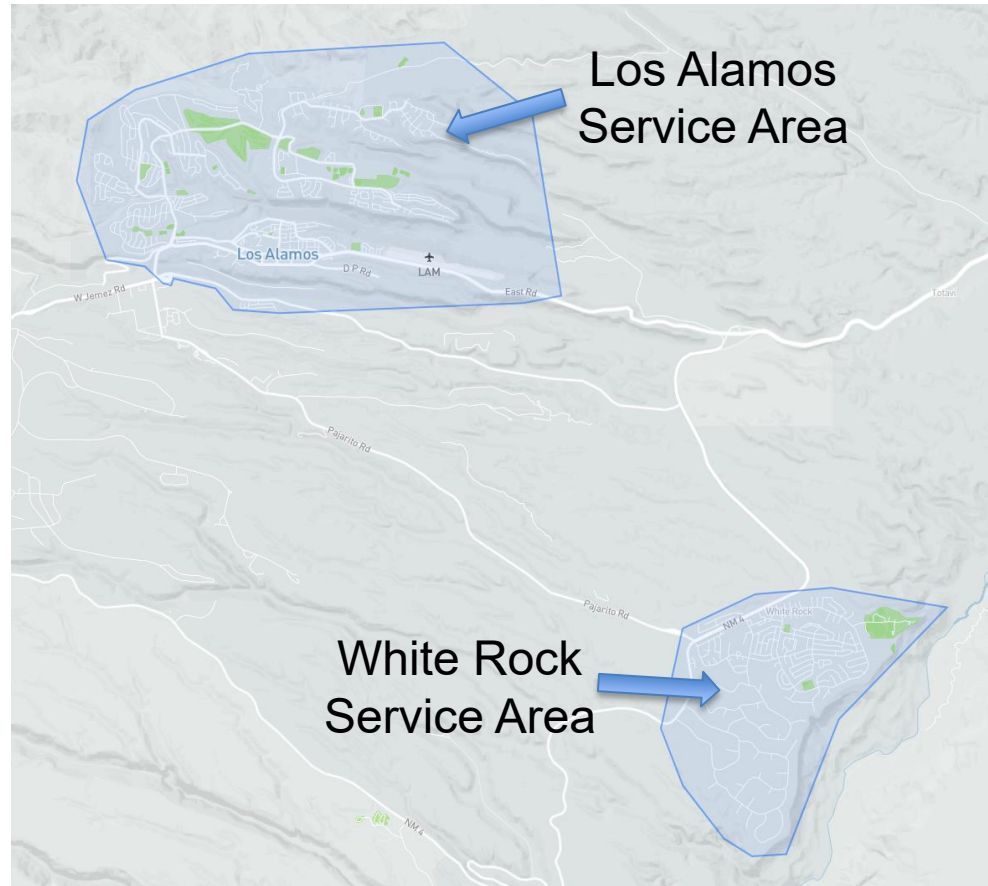
1 Dispatcher (4 existing staff on rotating schedule)

3 Drivers initially (Existing drivers signed up working OT)

# Key features of the Saturday Pilot

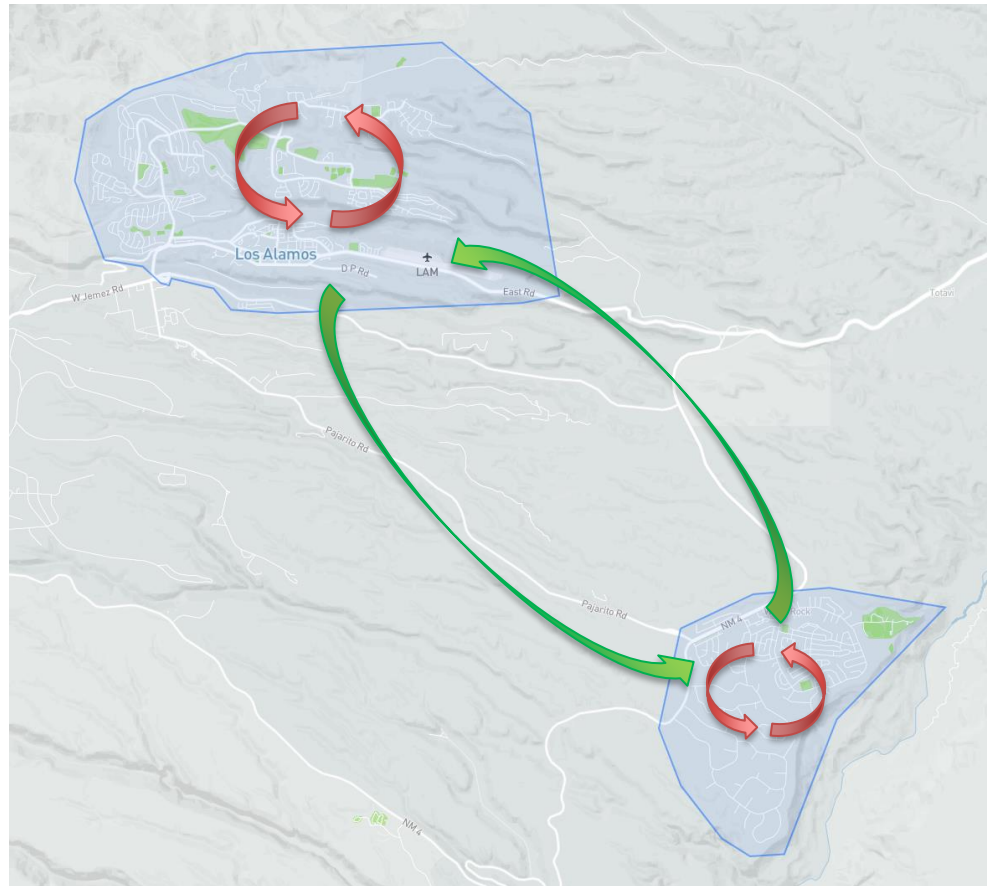
- MyRide on-demand Service: Passengers can request door-to-door rides within or between the designated service areas.
- Flexible Booking: Riders can make same-day requests on a first-come, first-served basis and book by calling 505-661-RIDE or using the MyRide App.
- Shared-Ride Approach: MyRide operates as a shared-ride service, meaning passengers may travel with other individuals going to similar destinations.
- Potential for Increased Mobility: This new pilot program aims to increase access to transportation for residents when traditional bus service is not provided.

# Service Area Map



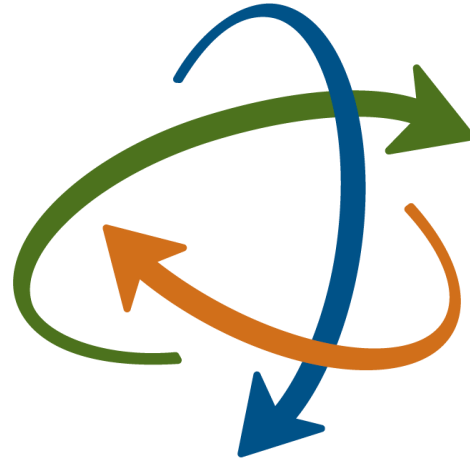
# Service Area Map

# Saturday Pilot Goal

- The pilot will allow ACT to test innovative transportation solutions and gather data to assess the effectiveness and potential for broader implementation. The goal is to provide residents with more options for getting around the community, potentially reducing reliance on personal vehicles, and improving overall mobility.
- Continual evaluation of ridership and types of trip requests. If demand for a specific Origin/Destination or time of day is high, larger vehicles or fixed route service could be utilized to accommodate ridership.
