Citizen's Petition

Subject: The 24"x 30" commemorative oil painting "The Boys of Pajarito Plateau" by the National Artist of the Boy Scouts of America and local business owner, Jeff Segler.

Requested Council action: Purchase of said painting by the County of Los Alamos. Price to be determined. This work could possibly be hung over the fireplace in the Curtis Room or in the Ante Room at Fuller Lodge.

The idea for the painting started in 2016, to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Los Alamos Ranch School (LARS). An extensive community survey was completed in 2019 by the Arts in Public Places Board (APPB) regarding public opinion on the purchase of the painting. An overwhelming 72% of respondents were in favor of the purchase.

The APPB essentially turned down the last opportunity to present the painting purchase to the Council based on misinformation about LARS. We are hoping the Council will give our community and its visitors this opportunity to incorporate the painting, which captures a moment in the life of the boys of Pajarito Plateau, into the historic narrative of Los Alamos.
