RDC Program of Work

Business Development

- **Business Retention & Expansion**

- Business outreach to assist businesses to increase revenue, create jobs, and grow their business.
- **199 BRE visits** in four-county region (**25 in Los Alamos**)
 - Mftg., technology, food/beverage, outdoor recreation, artisans, and tribal projects.
 - Most common challenges are marketing, workforce, facilities, financing, and material costs.

RDC Program of Work

- **Loan & Grant Programs**
 - TEAM (Tech & Mftg.) Fund
 - Tribal Grants
 - Micro-Grants
- **RDC Funding Outcomes**
 - 71 grants totaling \$409,594
 - 90 new jobs created
 - \$1.7 M in revenue increases

- \$1.6M DOE-Environmental Management - San Ildefonso Grant

RDC Program of Work

Capacity Building

- Equip communities and Pueblos to do economic development
 - EDO Roundtable Meetings
 - 28 entities including regional tribal development corporations.
 - Implement the **Regional Economic Development Initiative (REDI) Plan**
- 2025 REDI Summit
 - 200 attendees from business, resource, government, education & tribal entities.
 - Reviewed and updated REDI Plan based on current issues and challenges.

Los Alamos County & RDC 2026

- Services can evolve based on County priorities
- Support Los Alamos priorities/initiatives
 - Small business development/retail, tourism, outdoor recreation, housing
 - Host grant info. sessions and small business workshops in Los Alamos in February and April 2026.
 - Grants timelines, marketing, workforce, financing, add'l resources
 - Marketing & PR re: Los Alamos County & regional support
- **RDC Annual REDI Summit, March 5, 2026**
 - Launch TEAM Fund & Tribal Grants
 - Micro-grants open in June of 2026
