

1. Call to Order

Vice Chair Dolejsi called the meeting to order at 5:33pm.

3. Board Business

Renae Mitchell was selected to serve a second term and Frances Knudson is the newest member of the Library Board.

B. Review and approval of the September 13, 2021 Library Board Minutes:

Motion: Board member Mitchell, moved to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2021 Library Board meeting. Board member Knudson seconded the motion. Motion passed with all in favor (3/3).

C. Discuss and develop plan to phase in public in-person attendance at Library Board Meetings.

Vice Chair Dolejsi discussed the plan to phase in public in-person attendance at the library Board Meetings. With the COVID-19 numbers continuing to rise, it was decided to continue to hold the meetings via Zoom and revisit again in November.

Motion: Board Member Mitchell, motioned to continue the Library Board Meetings via Zoom and revisit again in November. Board member Knudson seconded the motion. Motion passed with all in favor (3/3).

5. Board/Staff Communications:

Mangers Report: Manager Sullivan reported there was a slight reduction in both physical and digital materials checkouts 27,630 total checkouts compared to 27,831 total checkouts in August. There were 45 youth programs and two adult programs last month. The two adult programs consisted of the Elva Osterreich author event Manhattan Project Trinity Test: Witnessing the Bomb in New Mexico that was hosted along with the Japan Institute and a Chautauqua program hosted along with the League of Women Voters. Youth Services continues to offer it's afterschool program in the Zone and added a new program called What's Up Wednesday which consists of varying activities. In September the activity was tabletop board games. Youth Services also hosted a program with Charles Gamble and the Santa Fe Opera on Improvisation. They collaborated with Recreation on the Family Campfire Night and S'mores walk where YS staff did in person story telling. The current exhibit in the Step-Up Gallery is the LA Photographers Club. Please check the calendar to see the upcoming events.

6. Q & A with Council Liaison

Councilor Reagor asked Manager Sullivan for an update on whether they had looked into restoring Sunday hours. Manager Sullivan reported that it was being looked at but for right now they were holding off on restoring hours since COVID cases continue to rise. There continue to be staffing issues related to COVID exposures. The COVID disruptions coupled with staff vacancies have created ongoing coverage problems. Recruitment is underway for vacant positions.
