

Los Alamos County Council FY 22 State Legislative Agenda

Support

- a. Legislation that provides sufficient funding for New Mexico public schools and higher education including full funding for capital outlay requests.
- b. Preservation of full-service Public Health Offices throughout the state, including in Los Alamos.
- c. Full and/or increased funding for projects to reduce risk of wildfire such as authorized under the Forest and Watershed Restoration Act.
- d. Legislation supporting Los Alamos County's application for capital outlay funding for NMSR4 water production pipeline replacement and DP Road utility and road infrastructure.
- e. Legislative priorities of NMC and NMML.
- f. Enhanced broadband access for all New Mexicans.
- g. Programs that enhance wage worker benefits and small business environment.

Monitor

- a. Tax reform legislation that directly affects Los Alamos County and/or its ability to serve its citizens.
- b. Distribution of federal funds to address serious infrastructure needs in Los Alamos County and throughout the state.

Oppose

- a. Changes to the state school funding formula that would adversely impact Los Alamos Public School District.
- b. Proposals that would reduce the County's net receipt of general GRT or other revenues.
- c. Legislation that limits H-class or Home Rule authority.
- d. Legislation that involves the preemption of existing County duties or authority.
