Hi,

I was not able to hang around to give my comments this evening. I am commenting as a member of the Open Space Advisory Subcommittee, and a Los Alamos resident.

My comment is regarding the third scenario presented. it wasn't clear to me that there were plans to reroute, rebuild, or otherwise replace the trail that would be affected under this plan. Any plan that will remove trail mileage should recognize that this is a cost to the community, above and beyond the monetary cost (that is, the lost opportunity to use said trails). These plans should ideally include costs to replace any lost trail mileage and/or access. You wouldn't put forward a plan that impacts the road without accounting for those costs, e.g. I don't know what the tradeoffs are with trail users in the area vs. numbers of golfers vs. revenue, but I am certain that there are more trail users than golfers in Los Alamos.

Secondly, the footprint vs. recreation potential of golf courses is generally low, and we are already pressed for space in Los Alamos. I don't think any expansion is the correct route. Let's first maintain, and then improve, what we have before expanding.

Attached is the presentation for next Tuesday's public meeting and below is the meeting information if you missed the media advertisement earlier in the week. We also put up posters at the golf course. I was not able to upload the presentation to the project website yet because our server that hosts our project information is having issues the past couple of days, but I know our IT staff are actively working on it. Tanner (sub-consultant to Andy) has still not provided us flight distance information on the reduced flight/60% compression balls, but they did say we should have it before Tuesday. I hope this information about what we have been working on since our July meeting is helpful. Lastly, I don't want anyone surprised when Andy Staples is not in attendance at the meeting. At this time, he has made a request of

the County not to continue any further with this project. It is likely we will be issuing a new RFP for design service once a path forward is determined.

County staff will conduct an informational public meeting Tuesday, Oct. 12, to discuss the Golf Course Site Development Improvements.

A hybrid meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 1000 Central Ave., and via Zoom.

A summary of the improvements include:

Driving range expansion, and the renovation/realignment of five holes;
Reconstruction of four greens (including one practice green;
Renovation/reconstruction of appropriate sand bunkers with liner;
Modification and construction of select teeing grounds;
Replacement/realignment of select gravel cart paths; and
Supply and installation of two vault type rest rooms as per plans and specifications.
As funding allows, reconstruction of the remaining putting greens and sand bunkers will be considered.
