Senior Centers: The senior center will close in-person lunch in January and just do drive thru and Home Delivered. They closed Thurs. and Fri. of Christmas week and closed half a day on Dec.31st for their first all staff training since Dec of 2019!

Ken Hendricks, Home Instead: They are still looking for more caregivers. Ken has helped with bell-ringing for Self-Help. He said that they raised over \$15,000 this year.

Jen Bartram: Also helped with bell-ringing. She has on-going counseling for grief groups through Golden Willow. She has found high levels of stress and anger in many people because of COVID.

Deni Fell: County Social Services--Reported that she has a new work phone number: 505-709-5916. There will be no COVID testing on Christmas or New Year's Eve. Contact the state Dept. of Health for Vaccine info. There will be interviews for Donna's job on Jan. 14.
