Project Scope:

The project proposes to develop a shared-use gymnasium located at the Los Alamos Middle School that will support County recreation programs and allow Los Alamos Public Schools' programmatic use during school hours.

Need:

Currently, the County and Schools share use of school-owned facilities for both School and County recreational programs. Due to numerous demands including community programs and school sponsored girls' and boys' athletic activities (games, tournaments, and practice events), space to accommodate all uses within reasonable times is limited.

Authorizations:

On December 17, 2019, County Council added the project to the Infrastructure Capital Improvements Project (ICIP) list, making the project eligible for a state capital outlay grant received in 2021. On February 28, 2022, in a Joint Session, the Los Alamos Public School Board and the County Council authorized the Pre-Design "Planning" Phase to evaluate the sites shown in the figure for the project.

Funding:

Project planning and up through roughly sixty percent (60%) of design is funded with a state capital outlay grant. Funding sources for design completion and project construction and related activities are not yet appropriated and will be further considered by County Council and the School Board as development of the project progresses.







One of the biggest issues with the current LAMS curricular building is that it was built "to size," meaning, it was built to accommodate the size of student body the school was currently serving. Those narrow halls? That was due to a failure to look toward the growth we've seen - and all teachers knew would come - when the building was built. They were supposed to be wider, but money was running out, and that was one of the places the building size was cut - to "the powers that be" at the time, that made sense since the school size then wouldn't require larger halls. We are paying the price for that lack of vision now with our larger student body size. Another consideration is the number of PE and PE related classes, the current lack of space for storage for most athletics, and the inability of the drama classes to use the only stage in the building because it is in the current gym. We have two PE classes meeting concurrently in the gym almost every period; Recreational Sports has to use the cafeteria for their class when that is the case. Drama cannot use the stage without significant scheduling whether there is one PE class or two meeting in the gym. The stage is also used for the wrestling team, making the stage completely off limits to drama during wrestling season. The storage areas on the stage, which should be used by drama, are filled with athletic and cheer equipment because they have no where else to store their things. There are wonderful programs currently at LAMS that cannot grow or even truly fulfill their current potential because of the lack of space and storage for those programs. Finally, LAMS has longed to be able to host multiple athletic events for years, but those same space and storage constraints make it next to impossible.
