It is anticipated that as of January 1, 2021, the County will have approximately 613 employees enrolled in PERA.

Within the next 5 years <u>at least</u> 119 employees will be eligible to retire (19.41% of our workforce)

333 employees are in Tier 1 & Public Safety (PS) (109 eligible to retire)

## **POSSIBLE RETIREMENTS\***

As of January 1, 2021 Include only Regular and Limited Term Employees

Are <u>ESTIMATIONS ONLY</u> and are based solely on employment information with Los Alamos County (years of service) and age.

These estimations **do not include** prior creditable PERA service (with another PERA employer), purchased airtime or retirement plan changes, thus employees may be eligible to retire sooner than indicated.

**Tier 1** – hired <u>before</u> July 1, 2013 General County 25-year Retirement Plan Public Safety 20-year Retirement Plan

**Tier 2** - hired <u>after</u> July 1, 2013 General County 30-year Retirement Plan Public Safety 25-year Retirement Plan
