B - LARES Interim Report

The ESB received a presentation from the Los Alamos Resiliency, Energy and Sustainability Task Force (LARES) interim report from Task Force Chair Katie Leonard.

<u>15156-21</u> Environmental Services Business & Operation Updates

Staff Liaison, Angelica Gurule, updated the Board on Environmental Services Business and Operations. The yard trimming program will be ending for the season the week of December 10, 2021 and Holiday tree collection will be in January 2022. Environmental services is sending excess mulch to the Caja Del Rio landfill in Santa Fe where it is being used to stabilize the slopes and prevent erosion. The Environmental Services Division in collaboration with the New Mexico Department of Game and fish purchased 300 semi automated Bear Tough roll carts and 7 bear proof dumpsters, of these 187 roll carts have been delivered to residents.
