General Information

Once a resident fills out and submits this application, an Interview is scheduled with the B&C's County Council liaison, the relevant staff liaison, and the B&C Chair. After the interviews, the applicants' names are presented to the full Council during a regularly scheduled Council meeting, where a vote is taken regarding the appointment of each applicant. Each applicant will be notified if they are appointed or not.

We had several overseas work assignments which diverted my work experience into more volunteer work. I started the Education Foundation in Oak Ridge, TN by organizing the foundation formation committee, getting our 501 C(3) designation, recruiting members for the first foundation board, and writing our mission statement and goals. Our first raise was for a public-private capital program to renovate our High School. We agreed to raise the money for funding the bonds so the local tax dollars did not have to raise significantly. We ended up raising \$8 million to fulfill this goal.
