

Borup Redesign #1- Sphinx Pose: The sphinx pose is when a lion has their belly to the ground, and hind legs positioned on each side of the body. This pose portrays similar feelings as the sitting pose but is more restful. The Sphinx pose is unlike the more common resting pose where the lion places its hind legs on one side of its body. The common resting pose could be interpreted as tired, lazy, or just too relaxed. The Sphinx pose on the other hand is used when the lion is resting but still needs to remain alert and watchful. Having the hind legs on both sides of the body allows the lion to get up quickly if needed and portrays the lion as ready to act.
