- Sites Southwest finalized the Open Space and Trails Management Plan (Summer 2025) that identify existing County services and opportunities as well as updated and consolidated existing documents.



On-Call Canyon Restoration Contract

- Natural Channel Design/Keystone Restoration
 - Completed Walnut Canyon conceptual design in Fall 2025



Operational Projects

- Tuff Riders Volunteer Project
 - Volunteers fixed a perpetually mud section of trail (100") by adding water diversions and crusher fines
- Trail Bridge Rehab
 - Sanded and weather treated 7 wooden bridges
 - Replaced hand railing on Peggy Sue bridge

Current Open Space and Trail Projects

- Bayo Canyon Trailhead Redevelopment project

Feral Cattle Removal

- Cattle have not been present on Los Alamos County Open Space since June 2025
- Continued collaboration with San Ildefonso Pueblo has helped control the herd size
- Around 200 have been removed since 2020
