Each applicant will be notified if they are appointed or not.

Currently, I am serving my first term on the Historic Preservation Advisory Board, hold the vice chair position, and wish to continue serving for another term. Additionally, I served for 3 years on the 557 Flats Condominium Owner’s Association here in Los Alamos as treasurer. I am also involved with the Alliance for Historic Landscape Preservation. A member since 2005, I served as a board member at large in 2009, the vice president from 2010 to 2012, the president from 2013 to 2017, and the immediate past president from 2018 to 2020. I also participated as a Volunteer in Parks at Chaco Culture National Historical Park from 2009 to 2019 and am a member in good standing in a few other professional/community organizations.

I have been employed by Triad National Security, LLC, for almost 5.75 years at Los Alamos National Laboratory and currently serve as their historical facilities technical lead. I have been working in the field of historic preservation for 30 years, and my previous positions and employers in this field include office director (2014–2020), senior historic preservation project director (2010–2020), assistant office director (2009–2014), and historic preservation project director (2007–2010) for Statistical Research, Inc., Albuquerque, New Mexico; cultural resources specialist (2000–2007) for AECOM (formerly EDAW, Inc.; formerly KEA Environmental Associates), San Diego, California; and assistant coordinator (1998–2000) and intern (1996–1998) for the South Coastal Information Center (California State Historic Preservation Officer [SHPO] Repository), San Diego, California.

I have a Master of Arts degree in Historic Preservation from Goucher College in Towson, Maryland, and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Anthropology from San Diego State University in California. I am a registered professional archaeologist (or RPA) and meet the education requirements for History Series 0170, as required by the U.S. Office of Personnel Management.

As a resident of a community, I feel that it is important to give back, whether it is through volunteering, donating money, or both. My experience in historic preservation is one of the skillsets from which I can draw on to support similar activities of the County and community members. I continue to be intrigued by the heritage (prehistory and history) of the region and want to continue to contribute to its preservation, interpretation, and enjoyment by the public. As a current member of the Historic Preservation Advisory Board, there are initiatives that I would like to see through to completion.

In general, I would like to provide any needed expertise to the Historic Preservation Advisory Board to meet their goals and objectives and for the Board to be effective in supporting the County's historic preservation efforts. To do this, I have three specific goals: (1) bring a better understanding to the Board of how the County identifies historic properties, determines effects to historic properties by projects, follows the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties, and communicates determinations with the SHPO; (2) understand the goals of the Historic Preservation Master Plan contract and support the project along the way and its outcomes; (3) encourage the County to employ or contract a Cultural Resources Specialist to support their projects and initiatives and implement the forthcoming Historic Preservation Master Plan.
