I believe that the Los Alamos Airport is important to Los Alamos County for a number of reasons - education, public safety, economic vitality, and recreation. At present there is no aviation expertise on the Transportation Board and there should be.

What would you like to accomplish during your tenure on this Board or Commission? (Please identify any special interests you have that led you to become interested in serving on this Board or Commission.)

In recent years, the number of resident aircraft and concomitant activity has shown a steady decline. I believe that to be due to the lack of a number of important features needed by a successful a public airport, and I would like to be part of helping the County add those to the airport operations and thereby increase airport use. The current Airport Plan is seriously out of date and I would like to be involved with the effort to update it.

I have talked briefly with the Deputy County Manager about my concerns about some aspects and airport developments.
