### A. Chair's Report - Shannon Blair

Chair Blair thanked Sue Barns for her service as Vice Chair and also mentioned there are two vacancies on the board.

#### 1). Board of Public Utilities - Sue Barns/Shannon Blair

Member Barns reported the January 14, 2026, BPU meeting, there were consent items approved, also reported that the new transformer for White Rock is on the way, being replaced with a higher compacity transformer. Mutual aid agreement with PNM in case there is another outage. Foxtail Flats operation date is now January 18, 2027, for full startup. Continuation of looking into Geo-thermal projects, on hold due to transmission holdups. Other items in the future Balcony Solar – Utah UAMPS presentation.

#### 2). Transportation Board -David Hampton

#### 4). County Council Liaison - Ryn Herrmann

Councilor Herrmann reported on the Council work session, had a presentation by the Regional Development Corp. (RDC) they work with Northern New Mexico giving grants to small businesses. Council was giving an introduction presentation on the North Mesa Masterplan, budget is \$13M dollars and the plan was well done.

Discussion on the MRA, two districts in White Rock and the other is Downtown East (Mari-Mac area) Council will be talking about it some more. Had a presentation by Mozart Devco, the power will go to Jemez Corp. What they want from Los Alamos is the trash. Councilor Herrmann suggested giving a presentation to ESB. County will be doing the community survey this year.

### **2). Los Alamos Sustainability Alliance - Sue Barns**

Member Barns reported that the Los Alamos Sustainability Alliance met and had discussion on a list of cooling centers in the County, also a list of items that are helpful in keeping cool in hot weather. Items to be given to the Fire Department to hand out and available at the library. Will have a work party to assemble packet on February 10th, in case anyone is interested in helping stuffing packets. The alliance was approached by Kristine Coblenz of the Jemez Trail Run committee; race is on May 9th and would like to ESB/LASA to host the Zero Waste station.

### **3). Education and Outreach Work Group**

Member Barns reported the working group is working with consultants Firebrand to roll out more educational outreach around Climate Action to the community, they will meet with here at the end of February for a few days.

### **4). Community-Wide EV Study Working Group**

Member Barns reported that the working group took all the feedback from ESB, Council, BPU and Stantec took all the information and put it into a spreadsheet and addressed it together with County staff, they are now working on a final plan. Final plan will go to Council and to ESB in February. Also, there are two EV chargers at the Hill Apartments.
