Presented by Tim Walker-Foster, Traffic & Streets Manager

Following a fatal pedestrian crash that occurred at the intersection of North Road and Urban Street, the Girl Scouts Pajarito Service Unit submitted a petition on March 25, 2026 on behalf of five (5) registered voters of Los Alamos County. The petition (shown in Attachment A) requested Los Alamos County to make the North Road and Urban Street intersection a Four-Way Stop.

On April 7, 2026, Council approved the following motion: "That Council acknowledge the petition, thank the petitioners for the recommendations and requests, and request staff and or an advisory board investigate and research the matter and return to Council with information, options, and a recommendation for action with 90 days."

Staff has completed the data collection and will present the analysis and recommendation for an All-Way (or Four-Way) Stop at this intersection.
