Celestino Crowhill

"Sky dancer" is a cast aluminum and tig brazed with bronze entry way inspired by the stairwells geopositioned astral map and re occurring iconography. The iconographic mold design tessellation is a map of the stairways geographical positioning which faces the milky way, mercury and the 13th zodiac at (N) 35.52.58.358 and (W) 106.18.8.937

On a personal level "Sky Dancer" is also inspired by two elders in my life who honored their perseverance by living by a creed of being kind, loving and nurturing. Their names are Betty Sue Mata and Wanj Naji. They had different backgrounds, different bloodlines, although they never met, their lives were weaved together into mine like stars within the same galaxy. I feel this concept is appropriate because it emphasizes New Mexico's rich culture, beautiful skies, sunlight, site specific education and it encourages us to reflect on our unique differences that can also be our unique similarities. These women have been pivotal in my recovery and transformation as an artist and the money will go to a place where my family can gather to create art for generations.

Scope of work

The technical methods and design concept is inspired by "Odetta" for its continued relevance through its brilliant design

The aluminum will be cast from its raw form from ingots then finished to a tangible round bevel at all of its edges. It will be polished to a semi-gloss finish. However, there is always an option to color this gate in any color and composition with powder coating.

I chose aluminum with bronze welds because these elements have a natural ability to highlight contrasts between light and dark with natural light. It is corrosive resistant, and it is lighter yet just as sturdy as carbon steel.

The molds are 6" squared respectively and 1/2 "or 5/8 "thick. They will be tig welded together at the joints with bronze.

The gate handle has an embossed feature that represents OLLIN, meaning movement and direction.

The sides and mid horizontal areas of the gate are braced by steel tubing. This is for the panic bar, lock box, hinges, back swing stops, and hinge pin door stop installation and other safety hardware ect

Specifications and Installation

Materials: Cast aluminum, Tig brazed joints, steel

The steel tubing and the door hinges are the gates main support structures. The steel tubing can either be anchored into the concrete by welding a small steel base plate to the tubing then anchored and or anchored into the brick wall by specific hardware like concrete anchors, butterfly anchors ect. I have installed many gates to cinderblock, concrete and stucco ect

Timeframe

With lead times for aluminum and steel expected to increase I am overestimating that this gate will take 4-6wks from ordering materials to complete installation. The weather is not an issue.

Maintenance schedule and safety concerns

I have designed this gate with the public in mind. All molds will be checked for burrs, polished, beveled and the openings are only est 3 " wide. It cannot be climbed upon, pried or bent at its openings, because of the steel tube braces and depth of molds. It will not need to be de rusted or dismounted and because of the panic bar and lock box and other safety hardware being attached to the steel and not the aluminum, it can be repaired without tampering with the molds. If vandalized, it can be resurfaced and welded in place and the master mold will be kept within my studio for future mishaps and replacements.
